PAL'S TNR PROGRAM

DID YOU KNOW?

Pet Adoption League and Allamuchy Township has been joining together to have a TNR program in our area.

WHAT IS TNR?

TNR is "trap/ neuter/ release". After humanely trapping cats that are homeless in our area, we take them to a local animal hospital that works with us to spay/neuter, vaccinate, and medically check them over. Cats that are feral are released, kittens are fostered, and friendly adult cats are eventually put up for adoption. Statistics show that removal and killing methods have failed because this opens the area to other cats. It is also cost-efficient and a reliable way to reduce stray cats because they can no longer reproduce!

DOES THIS BENEFIT MY COMMUNITY?

The areas that use this method will reduce the number of cats in their neighborhoods in two ways. First, by spaying and controlling population. Second, cats are territorial and they will prevent other cats from coming into the area. The spayed and neutered cats that remain in the area are truly a benefit to the neighborhood by controlling rodents and other animals coming in.

OUR GOAL!

Our goal is to try and educate the public on how important it is to spay/neuter your pets to control the vast number of cats being born every day to sometimes horrifying conditions.

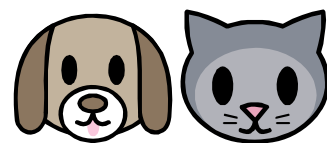

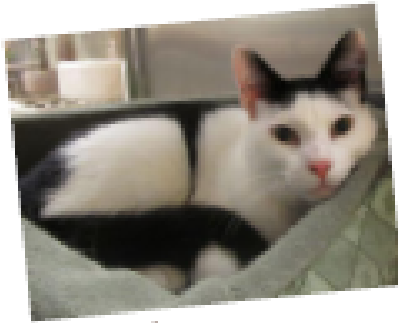

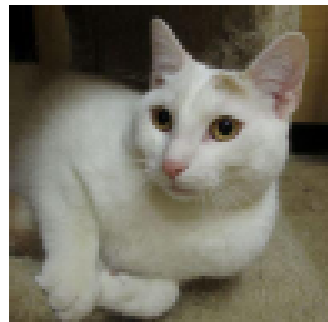

My name is Holden. I am almost a year old. I love to drape myself over your shoulder



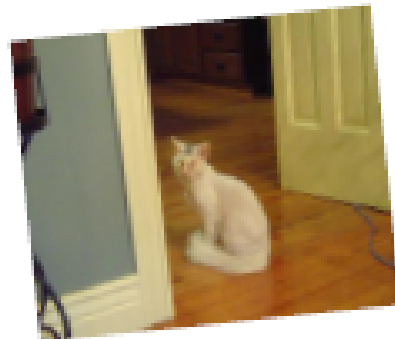

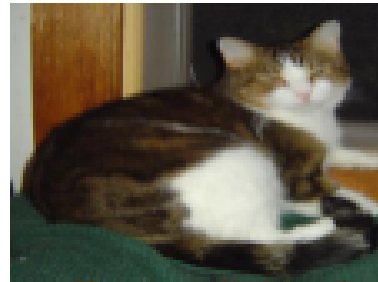
My name is Toby. I am the perfect gentleman, so charming-don't you think so! I love everyone. I would love you too. Take me home and see for yourself.



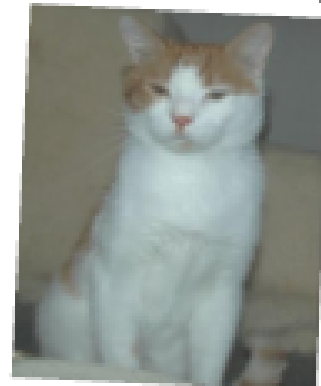
My name is Hitchcock. I am over a year old. I would love to sit on your lap and watch old movies with you!

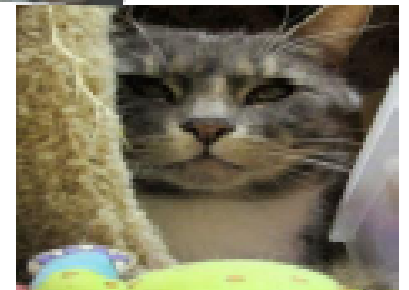

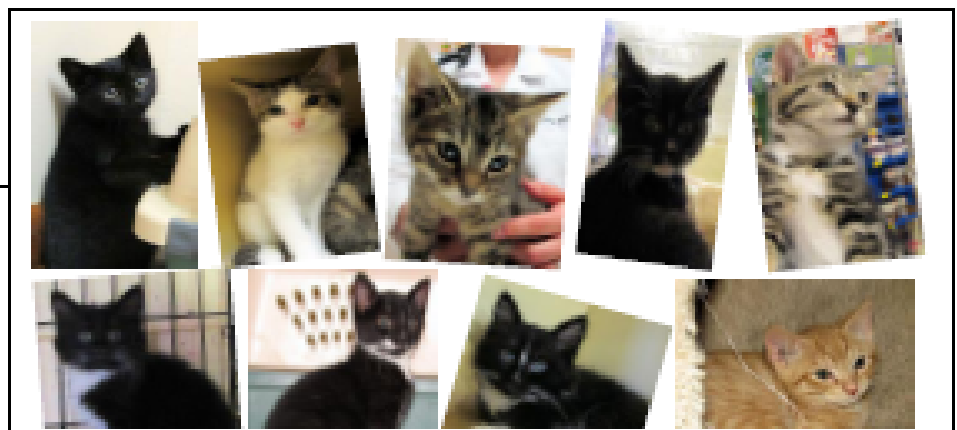
My name is Ginny. I am almost a year old. I am as sweet as I am beautiful. The picture of love. I would be so happy to be part of your family.

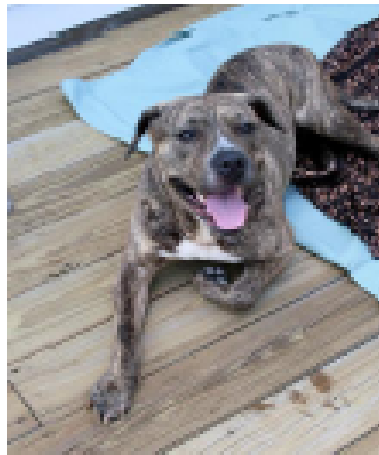
KITTEN CLUB

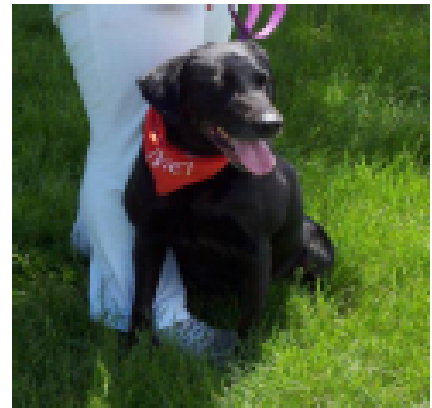

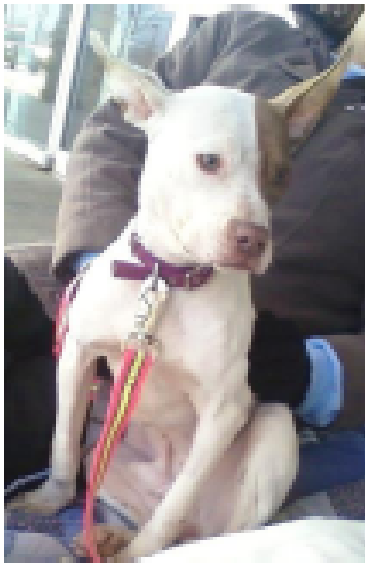
